

Post conference report

More than 300 participants from over 10 countries met at Taiwan from 19th to 22nd April, 2019 to exchange ideas and good practices, create and strengthen partnerships, and discuss the topic 'Landscape Conservation and Sustainable Development'. Participants of the 2019 International Conference on Landscape and Sustainable Development include representatives from Taiwan Forestry Bureau, Council of Agriculture, Executive Yuan, Geoparks Association of Taiwan, Central Geological Survey, MOEA, Construction & Planning Agency, Ministry of the Interior; representatives from Global Geopark Networks and experts from Taiwan, Japan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, France, UK, Canada, Australia, Germany, Poland, etc.

The conference was a platform for promote conservation for a sustainable human environmental future through geoparks, national parks, nature reserves, and local initiatives for sustainable projects. Besides, the UNESCO Global Geoparks, Satoyama initiative, and IUCN WCPA Green List are cases demonstrating endeavors of a macro- and transnational scope for sustainability. With 4 themes of the conference: National park management; Satoyama Satoumi; Landscape conservation, management of geoparks; Sustainable development, geological sensitive area, sustainable indicators, environmental education and 4 landscape and sustainable development forums, the conference created favorable conditions to share the good practice in landscape conservation and sustainable development.

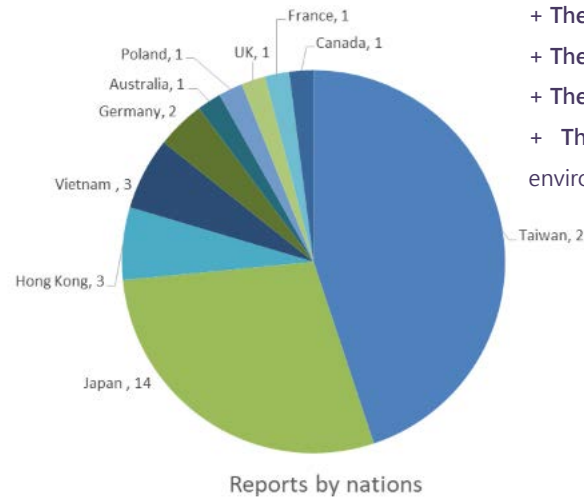

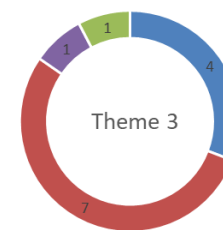

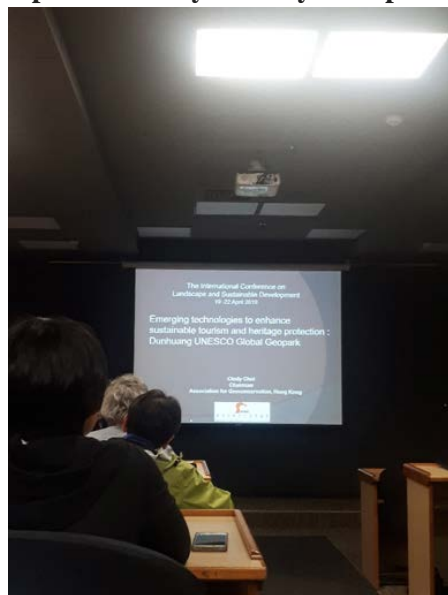
